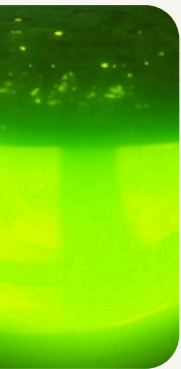

LOSiam is an artisanal extraction laboratory dedicated to one of the world's most botanically rich and underexplored fragrance territories: Northern Thailand.

Founded in 2022 and rooted in two decades of extraction expertise, we operate from CMU Biopolis in Chiang Mai, at the crossroads of Lanna botanical tradition and advanced green chemistry. Our mission is to bring the aromatic signature of this region into the palette of perfumers who demand both quality and provenance.

Every material in our collection begins in the field. We work exclusively with a network of over 30 local farming partners, sourcing hand-harvested botanicals at fair, agreed prices and processing them within hours of collection. This farm-to-flask discipline, from the sacred White Lotus gathered at dawn to the Chalood bark long used in Lanna incense and ceremony, is what makes our extracts both aromatic and irreplaceable.

Our process blends French fragrance heritage with solventless and green extraction technologies, producing premium absolutes and concretes that meet the highest international standards. Our products are IFRA compliant, allergen tested, and produced in full respect of the Nagoya Protocol.

Several materials in our catalogue exist nowhere else in commercial supply. We consider that a responsibility as much as a distinction.

LOSiam is more than a supplier. It is a laboratory, a territory, and a commitment to the art of natural fragrance.

## DESCRIPTION

A sophisticated evolution of the classic citrus profile. It opens with a vibrant, **citrusy-fresh top note** reminiscent of **citronella**, which swiftly transitions into a **complex heart of rosé geranium** and **spicy nutmeg**. The dry-down is remarkably distinct, offering a clean **leathery accord with smoky, wood-fire undertones** and a **peculiar candied ginger warmth**.

## USAGE NOTE

**Ta Krai Ton** is a plant that produce fruit **only once a year**. Hill tribes in Thailand commonly use the fruit as a **spice in cooking or eating** it with Laap (a spicy minced meat salad) to neutralize the gamey smell. We purchased the produce **from villagers in the mountains of Chiang Mai** that have a **roasting pre-treatment** which gives it this unique roasted and smokey scent .

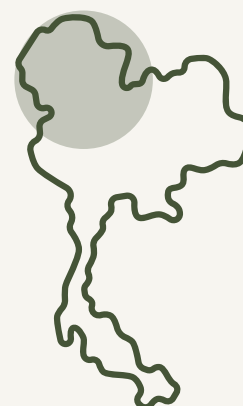

## USAGE NOTE

In the Lanna culture, Cape Jasmine is a popular choice to be grown in households gardens due to its **auspicious symbolism**. The white color of the Gardenia flower represents **purity of mind**, while its sweet fragrance symbolizes **the fragrance of morality**. For these reasons, Lanna people often offer Gardenia flowers as a form of **Buddhist worship**. Nowadays, it is common for locals to harvest the flowers in the morning and sell them at local morning markets.

Once believed to hold medicinal and aphrodisiac properties, it remains a **cultural staple** in rural Thailand. Our absolute is inspired by these macerations, made from a selection of Thai botanicals, offering perfumers a **spicy, liquor-like signature** with **strong identity and depth**

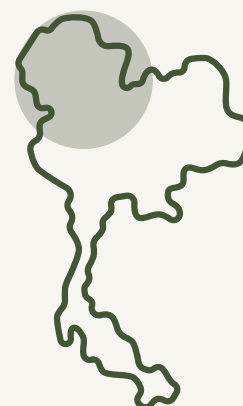

Saraphi is a refined **floral absolute from Northern Thailand**, combining a **violet-like brightness** with an **orris-style powdery softness**. The heart becomes **elegantly woody**, with a **subtle dry-fruit nuance** that adds depth and texture. A rare seasonal material with a distinctive, **sophisticated profile**.

## USAGE NOTE

Saraphi is a **perennial plant**, medium to large size. It has a height of about 12-20 meters. The white flowers are fragrant. Saraphi is **native to Southeast Asia**. In Thailand, Saraphi flowers can often be found in mixed forests and evergreen forests in the northern region. During the Songkran festival, northern people like to use dried Saraphi flowers to make Sompoi water. It is believed to be **holy water used to bathe Buddha statues**.

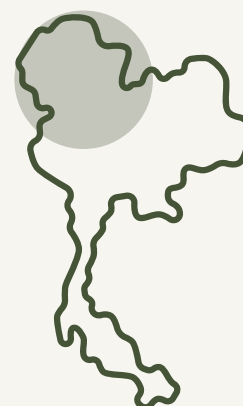
